WHAT YOU CAN DO

DIRECT SERVICES

Answering Hotline: Provide crisis intervention and work with case managers. 40-hr DV Training plus counseling training is required. Fluent Korean speaker needed. Flexible volunteer hours. Can work at home.

Being Mentors for Children: Build a long-term supportive relationship with a child whose mother has suffered from domestic violence. Help children with homework and encourage extracurricular activities. Flexible schedule. 40-hr DV training or equivalents, and a 9 month (a minimum of 4 hours/month) commitment are required. Some experience with kids a plus.



ESL Individual Tutoring: Provide English-language instruction and tutorial assistance to immigrant women. Flexible hours on evenings and weekend. Some knowledge of domestic violence issues is desired.

Job Skills Development Program: Assist clients with job skills such as computer skills or other empowering life skills.

Legal & Social Service Advocacy: Accompany clients to court or hospitals as needed and provide emotional and informational support. Work with legal advocate staff.

NON - DIRECT SERVICES

Translators/Interpreters: Provide translation as needed. Bilingual individuals (Korean/English or Chinese/English) encouraged to apply.

Fundraising & Special events: Help plan and coordinate annual benefit dinner or other fundraising events. Research funding sources or assist with grant-writing. Some knowledge or experience with marketing/PR is a plus.

Newsletter Project: Participate in planning process, research, write, edit, or translate articles, assist with distribution or gather feedback.

Community Outreach/ Education:

Assist with 40-hr DV training coordination, staff information booths at community events and fairs, assist with media education program, develop and maintain resource library, and more.



Technical Support: Provide tech support & trainings to the staff. Experience and knowledge with the Microsoft Office, Adobe, network, and website development a plus.

Administration: Help with administrative tasks, including data entry, data base development, research, filing, and more.
