POSITION: Faith-Based Field Advocate (Part-time)

The mission of KAN-WIN is to eradicate all forms of violence against women, including domestic violence and sexual assault, by empowering Asian American survivors and engaging the community through culturally competent services, community education and outreach, and advocacy. KAN-WIN is a non-profit, community-based organization that supports Asian American women and children victims of domestic violence and sexual assault in Chicago and its surrounding suburbs. KAN-WIN's services include 24-hour domestic violence crisis line, counseling, legal/social benefits advocacy, Transitional Housing and Children's program, and community education/outreach. Job Responsibilities:

The Faith-Based Field Advocate partners with KAN-WIN staff to: 1) conduct outreach and education to the faith-based community, specifically in Korean community and 2) provide support, information and advocacy to victims of domestic violence. More specifically, the Faith-Based Field Advocate will be responsible to:

- Act as a representative of KAN-WIN when speaking with faith-based community members with a goal of raising awareness around the gender-based violence issues and victim services.
- Provide community outreach and education through presentations, media and other means to promote victim services.
- Outreach to churches and clergies for online pilot test on domestic violence issues
- Leading trainings for faith leaders in Korean American Churches
- Provide feedback on training and performance objectives
- Help develop storylines for domestic violence cases and identify additional resources for clergy
- Review and revise simulations-interactive process for the online education materials
- Provide translation assistance for simulations/online education tools to Korean

Required Qualifications:

- Fluency in English and Korean
- Commitment to issues concerning gender-based violence to faith-based community
- Ability to work with individuals in crisis situations.
- Ability to work independently, as well as in a team.
- 40-hour domestic violence training.
